

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LAURELVIEW CAMP

Buildings and Grounds

- All grounds are available for your group's use including the upper barn for recreation, the pavilion, outdoor camp fire pits and pond.
- Only the buildings you are renting are available for your use.
- Food preparation and serving is to be done in the kitchen that has been assigned to your group
- In order to keep the costs down of using Camp Laurelview, each group is required to do a certain amount of cleaning. See cleaning expectations for each building and Last Day Check Out Cleaning List.

Upper Barn

- Recreation equipment may be used in the upper barn
- Do not use the golf cart stored in the upper barn
- No candles or any open flame in the barn.

Pond Use

- Fishing for catch and release is permitted if children are accompanied by an adult.
- Please bring your own fishing gear
- No swimming allowed
- You may feed the fish with bread and bits of food, but please do not throw stones or debris into the pond

Fireplace and Outdoor Fire Pit Usage

- Fires are permitted at the outdoor camp fire pits and in the fireplaces in the Director's Cabin and Dining Hall
- Fires should never be left unattended; flues should be double checked open before building fires and closed when fire has died. Ashes should be disposed of in a responsible manner.
- Firewood is provided in the wood shed near the outdoor campfire ring

- There is a phone in the Director's Cabin and Dining Hall

Emergencies

- Call 911

- Please call your Camp Host to report any emergency calls
- First Aide kits are available in the Director's Cabin and in the Kitchen in the Dining Hall

Equipment

- Use of outdoor grills is permitted a safe distance from any structure.

Strictly Prohibited for Your Safety

- No motorized, off-road recreational vehicles permitted beyond designated parking areas.
- No fireworks
- No firearms are permitted
- No food allowed in dormitory cabins
- No alcoholic beverages
- No illegal drugs
- No smoking inside or within 50 feet of every building
- No hunting allowed.
- No swimming in pond.
- No pets

Notify Camp Host Immediately

- Any calls to 911
- Any damages, lost equipment or non-functioning equipment or appliance
- Someone is on the grounds who is not a part of your group (Please note this may be someone with the Laurelview Camp, but it is always best to call the Camp Host)

LIST OF WHAT RENTERS NEED TO BRING TO CAMP:

- Food, including condiments and coffee
- Bedding (including sheets, pillows, and blankets)
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries: soaps, shampoos
- Paper products: toilet paper, paper towels, kleenex
- Flashlights
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- Fishing poles and bait
- Recreation equipment
